



Agencies Supporting Housing Outreach and Eviction

Housing outreach and eviction prevention agencies work to help individuals and families access resources to help avoid eviction or gain access to a shelter when experiencing homelessness.

If you are homelessness and in immediate need of shelter contact:

Services offered by housing outreach/eviction workers:

- Finding affordable housing
- Discussing leases with landlords and contracts
- Bus tickets (for transportation to a shelter)
- Referral services for financial support (Ontario Works) or immediate programs for those with court ordered evictions (N4 form from landlord) to pay rent arrears and avoid eviction.
- Subsidized Housing application support
- Budgeting Supports
- Support with your rights and responsibilities with the landlord tenant board
